Parishes Youth Group: we are excited to announce that we are starting a new Youth Group in cooperation with St Peter's for 11-16 year olds. The monthly meetings begin on Sunday 17th December at 6pm till 7.30pm, with faith, fun, and food. Interested parents can ask Canon Gargaro for a consent form. This develops our deepening links with St Peter's as part of our pastoral area (alongside our joint RCIA programme) and these links allow both parishes to do things that neither could arrange on their own.

Caring Sunday: takes place next Sunday, 17th December, supporting the St Nicholas Care Fund. There will be a special collection to support their work and there are packs available at the back of the church this week with newsletters and gift-aid envelopes for you to bring back next weekend.

Advent Confessions: we will have our parish extra Confessions for Advent on Wednesday at 6.30pm, and we will be joined by Canon Anthony Gallagher to hear the Confessions. During the time of Confession we will have Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, so please come along to pray even if you don't want to go to Confession here.

As well as the usual times here, there are also daily Confessions in the Cathedral (12.30pm-1pm), in St Aloysius (11.45am-12.15pm), and in St Mungo's (10.30am-11am). St Peter's have Confessions every Tuesday and Thursday from 6.15pm to 6.45pm. The Cathedral will hold a day of Confessions on Tuesday 19th December – take the chance to go along and prepare for Christmas.



Advent Big Clean: will take place on Monday 18th December at 6pm, so please come along and help get the church ready for Christmas. We've been promised pizzas for the helpers, so don't miss out!
