Mass Census: we had 118 at Mass for the census, down slightly from last year when we had 122, so basically our attendance is consistent.

Sacristy Roof: there has been a bit of water ingress above the sacristy – you can see the staining if you go to the toilet – and the builders tell us that we need to do work on the guttering. This will cost up to £4000, depending on exactly what they find when they start work. Once the work is completed we will also need to look at cleaning up the inside and maybe redecorating.
