Retreat: Canon Gargaro will be away on retreat this week for a few days of spiritual renewal, something priests are obliged to do and everyone is encouraged to do. As a result there will be no Mass in the parish Tuesday to Friday and the church will not be open.

Day of Prayer and Fasting: Pope Francis has asked us to join him and the whole Catholic world in praying for peace and reconciliation in the Holy Land on Friday 27th October, and by offering up a fast (only one meal that day), if you are able, as a penance for the hatred and violence in the world. Here in the parish we will have Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament from 6.30pm and Rosary at 7pm, concluding with Benediction. Please join us for that service, and if you cannot please join in private prayer as best you can.

November Lists: are available at the back of the church. Please write the names of your beloved dead and put the list in the envelope with your donation, and then place them in the box provided. Masses during November will be offered for them.

Mass for the Dead of the Past Year: we will offer Mass for all those whose funerals have taken place in our parish over the past year at 10am Mass on Sunday 5th November. The families will all be invited to come and light a candle for their loved ones, which will burn at Father Lynch's altar throughout November.

Confirmation Preparation: our P7 children will celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation in St Mungo's on Tuesday 14th November at 7pm. Please keep them and your families in your prayers. To help get them ready for this celebration we will have the usual Pre-Sacramental Sessions for parents and children after 10am Mass on 29th October, 5th November, and 12th November, which all the parents and children should attend.
