**Safeguarding:** please remember that all of us need to be careful to protect everyone in the parish. The Scottish Bishops tells us that "everyone in the Catholic Church in Scotland...values the lives, wholeness, safety and wellbeing of each individual person within God's purpose for everyone." This includes being careful about what we say or do to other people, especially the young and the vulnerable – we must never grab hold of children, except when necessary to protect them (e.g. to stop them running onto the road).

**Lighting**: during the week we got all the bulbs in the chandeliers replaced and the broken fittings fixed, so everything is a bit lighter now.

**May Devotions:** finish today (Sunday) with Rosary and Benediction at 5pm. Please do make the effort to come along and pray for Our Lady's intercession and receive the Sacramental Blessing of her Son.

**Deanery Council**: as the next stage in the process of "Looking to the Future" the Deanery Council, made up of all the parish priests and one representative from each parish, will meet on Tuesday to discuss each parish's ideas about evangelisation (as shared in the bulletin for the past couple of weeks) and help plan for the future.

**First Friday**: the school will join us on Friday for 9.30am Mass to mark the First Friday of June. Since the First Friday devotions are in honour of the Sacred Heart, and since June is the Month of the Sacred Heart, this is a special occasion for praying for our children. Please join us in person or in prayer wherever you are.

**Feast of the Visitation at Carfin**: On 31 May, Bishop Brian McGee will lead a service of prayer at Carfin Grotto at 7.00 pm in preparation for the Synod gathering in Rome later this year.

**Linn Cemetery Mass:** This year's Linn Cemetery Mass will take place on Saturday 10th June at 3pm. Fr Ian Bathgate will be the main celebrant.

**Annual Pilgrimage to Scalan:** The Annual Pilgrimage to Scalan takes place on Sunday 2nd July with Mass outdoors at The Scalan beginning promptly at 4.00pm. Scalan can be found a mile beyond Chapeltown of Glenlivet. An approximate postcode is AB37 9JS. Coaches need to stop half a mile beyond Chapeltown. Cars and minibuses can park very near and are usually willing to take anyone needing a lift.


